Deliveries to consumer residences are excluded. Effective February 29, 2016, processors of certified "organic" and "100 percent organic" fluid milk products may apply for an organic assessment exemption for those products.

3/ The Transportation Credit Balancing Fund is a marketwide assessment on Federal Order 7 pursuant to §1007.81 of the order. The per hundredweight assessment is applied to the total pounds of Class I producer milk.

4/ The Distributing Plant Delivery Credit Fund is a marketwide assessment on Federal Order 6 and Federal Order 7 pursuant to § 1006.84 and §1007.84 of the orders. The per hundredweight assessment is applied to the total pounds of Class I producer milk.
